CALL for ENTRIES part TWO!

Objective:

In conjunction with the *Wyoming's Green Backyard Seminars @ The AIA Wyoming Fall Conference & The Arteducology Symposium in Casper, AIA Wyoming* invited Architects, Interior Designers, Engineers, Landscape Architects, Contractors, and other design and construction professionals to submit their Greenest Projects (in the Backyard!) for a special Showcase that was exhibited @ The Nicolaysen Art Museum throughout the Conference.

The intent was to offer a showcase of work being done around the state in a non-awards year, but also to act as a catalyst for conversation; About sustainability, ecology, the built environment, and how art, architecture and education is integral to the health of our daily lives and communities at large.

The call is open to all design professionals, you do not need to be an AIA Wyoming member, but the projects need to be in the state. **The Showcase will be exhibited @ several locations around the state in the next year.** Committee members are still needed to help steer this project forward and is a great opportunity to inspire and educate Wyoming's citizens.

Eligibility:

Design and Construction professionals are invited to submit projects regardless of project size, budget, style, or building type. All are welcomed and encouraged, both established and new designers and practitioners and from firms of any size. New buildings, restorations and Un-built projects are eligible. Firms are encouraged to re-enter projects previously submitted for awards.

There is no limit to the number of projects that may be entered by a firm, however entries must be submitted by the Firm of Record, or the Architect of Record.

Format:

30x42 Foamcore Board **One Project per Board.** **\$25 per Board**

Boards, Entry fees and forms are due no later than Monday March 1st, 2010.

Note: All Fees will be used for future shipping and expenses with the traveling show.
